What is autism?

- ➤ May appear in children ages 2 -3 years old
- Refers to a broad range of conditions characterized by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviors, speech and nonverbal communication
- Accompanied by sensory sensitivities and medical issues such as gastrointestinal (GI) disorders, seizures or sleep disorders, as well as mental health challenges such as anxiety, depression and attention issues
